GRAPES

100% Cabernet Sauvignon

VINEYARD

AOG Zenata Carefully selected parcels from the Domaine Ouled Thaleb in Benslimane. The vineyard is situated on sandy shales and sand gravel soil. Vinified and bottled at the Domaine. All vineyards are ploughed and weeded by hand and no herbicide or fungicide treatments are used.

AGEING

Aged 13 months in 2/3 new French oak barrels.

TASTING NOTES

Dark color with garnet hues. Bright green tinged (pepper/herbs), black fruits with black cherry and cassis and slightly sweet oak. The wine is firmly tannic, well balanced and tightly wound with an old world charm.

Aged in 1/3 new Francois Freres oak barrels for 12 months.

TASTING NOTES


Red ruby color. Slight gamy/bacon edge to wild berry fruit and smoky spice. Lifted and quite fresh. In the mouth the wine shows blackberry and spice with moderate tannins, moderate acidity and well integrated oak. Finishes fresh and lively.


Bright gold color and green hues. Green Apple and baked pear on the nose. Mineral and wet rock scent. A fresh and clean chardonnay wine with great acidity.



Dark purple ink color. Darker cabernet nose (black cherry, cassis & plum) with integrated oak and earthen framework. In the mouth the wine is juicy, kirsch-like, leathery and delicate with soft tannins.




Grapefruit, orange blossom, passion fruit, elderflower and spearmint on the nose. The wine is floral and aromatic, fresh, bright and grassy.



TASTING NOTES





Vinified and bottled at the Domaine Ouled Thaleb in Benslimane. All vineyards are ploughed and weeded by hand and no herbicide or fungicide treatments are used.

AGEING

Aged in French oak barrels.

TASTING NOTES

Gold and bright in color. Baked apple and caramel, lemon meringue on the nose with the oak coming through with vanilla and nutmeg. Finishes round, rich, textural with buttery and toasted notes. A voluptuous wine.
