

Who knew you could produce stunning results in California with Italian varieties? Lorenzo Petroni knew. He was the first California vintner to grow the prized Sangiovese Grosso clone. The sassy Rosato di Sonoma is crafted from Sangiovese, Cabernet Sauvignon, and Syrah grapes grown in Petroni's estate vineyards, one of which overlooks the Sonoma Valley from high in the Mayacamas Mountains.
